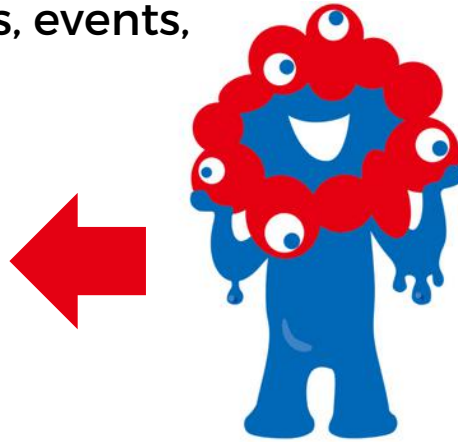


# YURU KYARA

  - First established after Tohoku earthquake in 2011

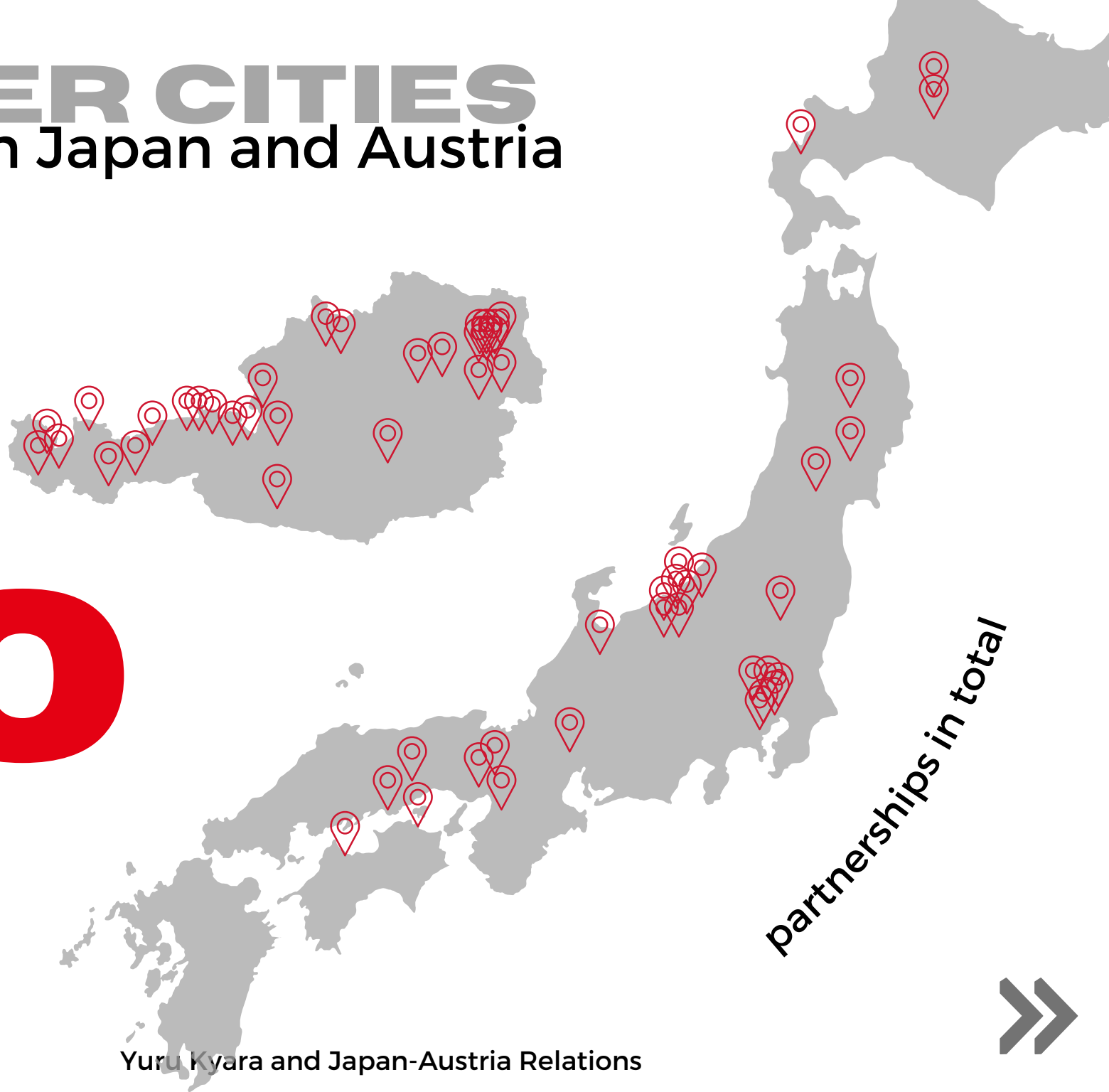

### Hanamaki Onsenkyo

12 hot springs (Hanamaki Onsen, Dai Onsen, Matsukura Onsen, Shidotaira Onsen, Watari Onsen, Osawa Onsen, Yamanokami Onsen, Namari Onsen, Shinnamari Onsen, Kanaya Onsen, Hanamaki-kita Onsen, and Towa Onsen) with a wide variety, ranging from 600-1200 years old traditional Onsen to modern ones, from rock baths to open-air baths etc.

### Wanko Soba

A style of Japanese Soba noodles originating from the area consisting of small bowls (wanko) of Soba

(Japanese buckwheat noodles) which get consistently refilled/replaced while eating

# ゼロング Zerong



Hanamaki

**Zerong** who normally lives as *Yotsugi Aoto* is a hero who protects Katsushika Ward from the evil clutches of Deathbal. When he was captured by Deathbal, he was identified as having compatible genes (which is rare) , so he was given a shooting card and gained his powers. However, he chose to fight for the good side.



## Special Secret Police (SSC)

A special group formed to help protect Katsushika, lead by *Mizumoto Makoto*.



**Zerong Nr. 2-5** are heroes fighting alongside Zerong to protect the ward, also having been injected with the shooting card by Deathbal but fighting for the good.



## Deathbal

Organization with up to 12 different villains trying to turn Tokyo into an evil independent state, starting from Katsushika ward. They tried to make Aoto into their first superweapon via the shooting card but failed, creating the hero Zerong.

There are also several statues scattered throughout the district

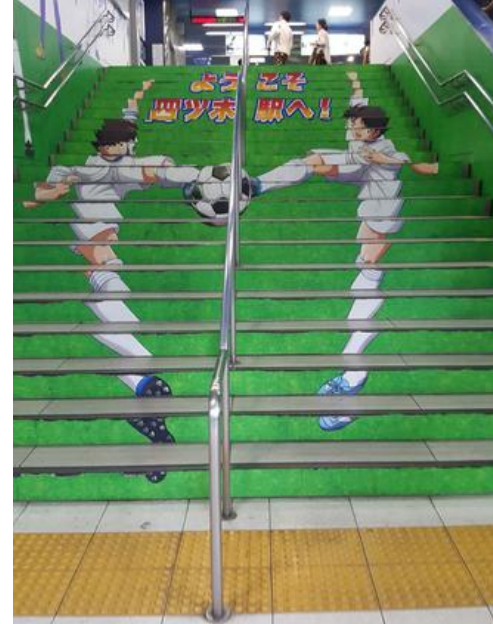

## Charming Points:

- 'Spring horse' symbol on his chest from which he sends a 'spring horse beam' in early spring, when the life force of the mountains reaches its peak to make everyone happy
- Sweating from 7 different hot springs when getting impatient
- Can fly up to 2454 metres as a hero

**Age:** 753 years (but said around 25 years old in human age)

**Personality:** Used to be mischievous, often spewing lava from his head, but has recently become more rounded watching over Myoko city from the top of Mt. Myoko with a confident face

**Job:** Training in the mountains, mountaineering /trekking guide and temporary instructor at ski and snowboard schools (he is as good as a pro)

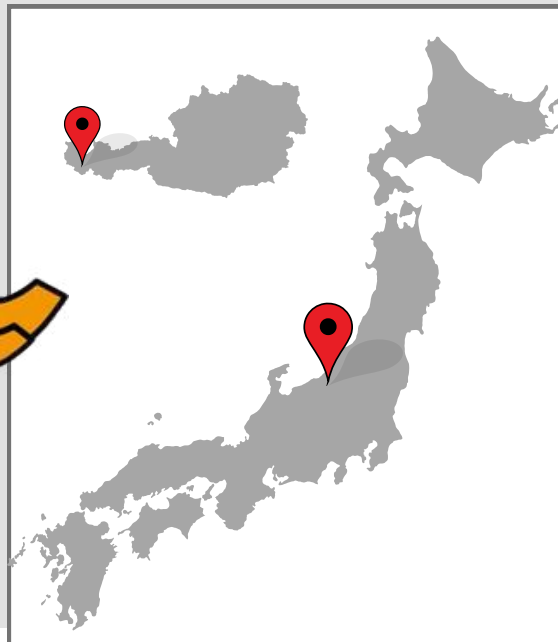

Sister City Agreement with Schruns-Tschaggungs since: **2004**

**Location:** North-Central Niigata prefecture, in the mountain surroundings near the historical entrance to the Echigo Plains (3-4 hours by car/train from Tokyo)



**Alps:** Just like Schruns-Tschaggungs, it is surrounded by mountains, namely by the by five mountains Mt. Madarao, **Mt. Myōkō**, Mt. Kurohime, Mt. Togakushi and Mt. Iizuna which are collectively known as the Five Mountains of Northern Shinshu and also home to Mt Hiuchi and Mt. Takatsuma of the 100 Famous Japanese Mountains

**Name:** Lerch-san (or Theodor von Lerch)

Lerch-san is inspired by a real-life Austrian soldier who is well-known to many people in the prefecture and was first introduced as a character for the '100th Anniversary of the Birth of Skiing in Japan'.

### From Austrian Mountains to Japanese Mountains

Major Lerch first introduced skiing to Japan, teaching his first lessons in January, 1911 on Mt. Kanaya in Joetsu and continued to teach military and civilians in the region. He also skied on Mt. Fuji

Sister City Agreement with Lilienfeld since: **1981**

**Location:** Niigata prefecture bordering the Sea of Japan (3-4 hours by train/car from Tokyo)

**Japanese Alps:** Joetsu is surrounded by the Japanese Alps with four famous mountains Mt. Kasuga, Mt. Kanaya, Mt. Yone, Mt. Hishigatake.



**Skiing:** After Japan-Russo war, European powers sent troops to Japan for the country to study new methods of combat, among them Austro-Hungarian major **Theodor von Lerch** teaching the **"Lilienfelder"** method of skiing

winery and hike along the many beautiful wine valleys across Azumino.



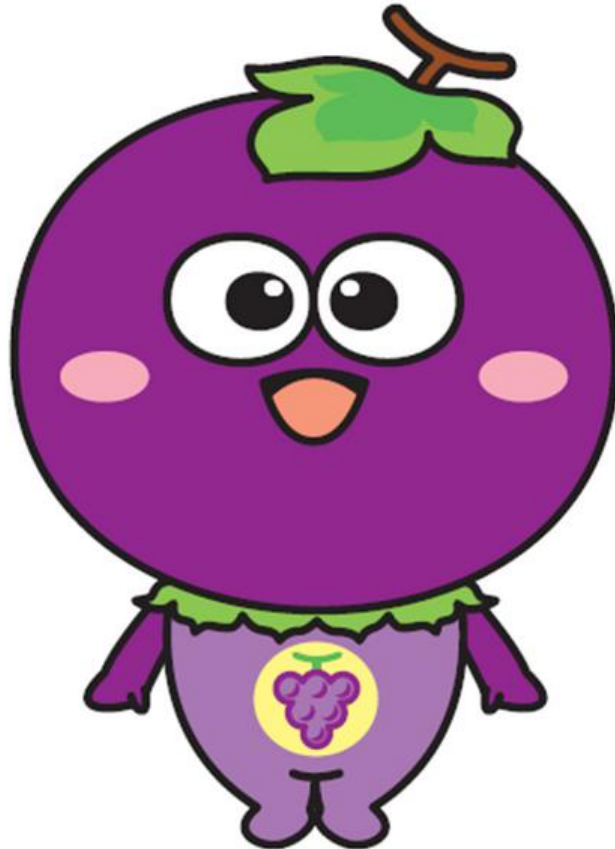

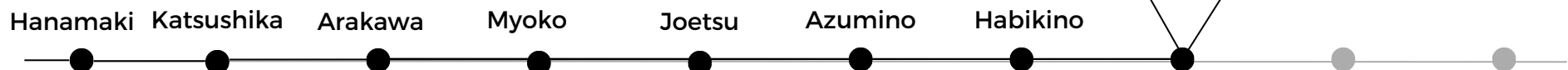
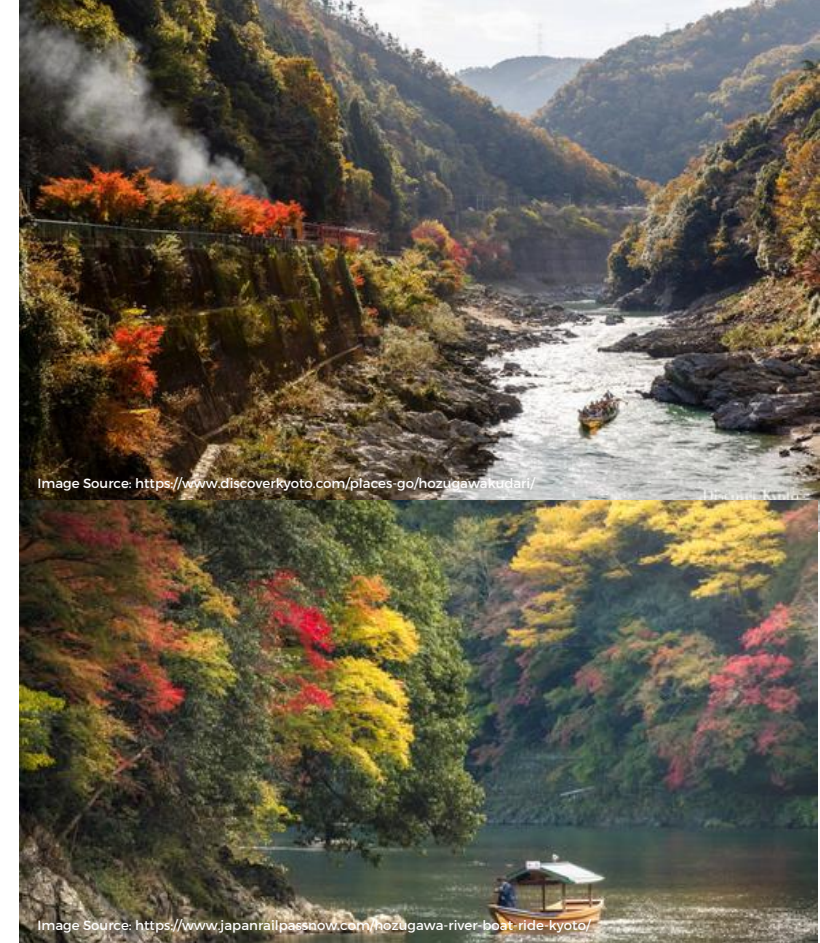
# Kameoka, Kyoto

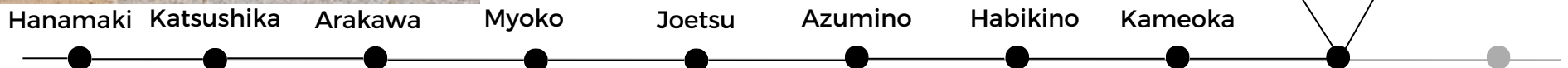
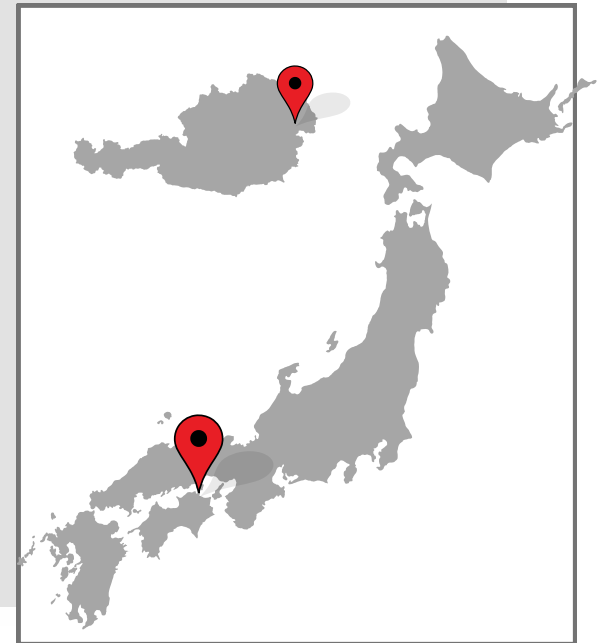

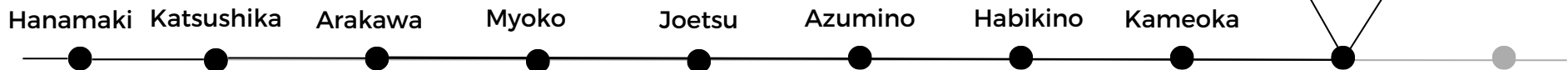


## Famous Udon

With white sand and calm waves, Tsuda no Matsubara beach is one of Japan's top 100 beautiful beaches. It is part of the "Setonaikai National Park", looking out over the Setouchi islands with impressive ancient pine trees (over 600 years old). 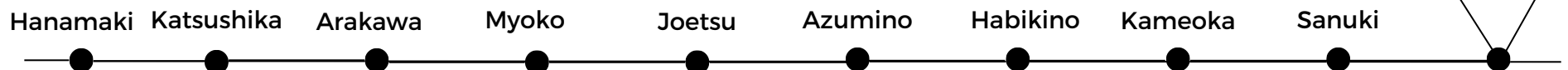
## Saijo, Ehime

### Spring Water Capital of Japan

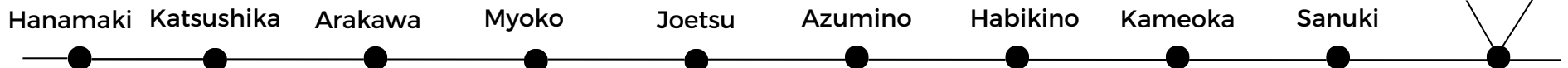
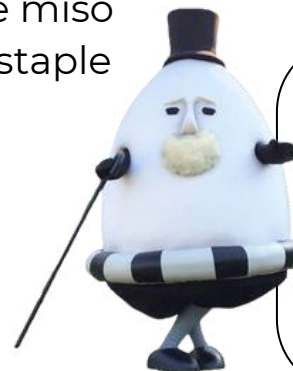
